# Learning from Ants

*“If you catch 100 red fire ants as well as 100 large black ants, and put them in a jar, at first, nothing will happen. However, if you violently shake the jar and dump them back on the ground the ants will fight until they eventually kill each other. The thing is, the red ants think the black ants are the enemy and vice versa, when in reality, the real enemy is the person who shook the jar. This is exactly what’s happening in society today. The real question we need to be asking ourselves is who’s shaking the jar... and why?”*

The above observation by Shera Starr cannot be improved upon.

And yet, the answer to the question is fairly simple.

But let’s first take a look at this anomaly. It’s natural to identify with some individuals more than others. That tendency occurred before *Homo sapiens* came into being. In addition, the tendency for animals to group into families or packs also predates humans. We tend to want to be around those who behave the way we do and have the same perceptions as we do. That only makes sense. We wish to surround ourselves with those who are unlikely to surprise and possibly even endanger us by behaving in a fashion that we would not ourselves choose.

This is the basis of trust – an essential in group or herd mentality. And being a part of a group or herd brings to us increased safety.

So, what then, of those who are not within our group or herd? How do we relate to them?

Well, any nature programme that covers animals gathered around a water hole can provide that answer.

We see a small group of wild pigs drinking alongside a group of wildebeests. Neither species is predatory, so they learn to recognise that, even though one group is made up of savannah-living grazers and the other are forest-living foragers, they can easily co-exist, which will increase the ability of both species to use the water hole at the same time.

We might also see a group of hyenas using the water hole, but we notice that the prey animals all seek to keep a distance between themselves and the predatory hyenas.

Everyone understands that they are all at the water hole for the same reason and it makes sense to share, even if, in another situation, they are natural enemies.

In fact, in most of nature, we see that species adapt to a condition of mutual tolerance in order to be able to coexist.

No surprise, then, that *Homo sapiens* got on the mutual tolerance bandwagon in its formative stages and, for the most part, has remained that way.

But it is also true that predators develop dual habits. They may exercise tolerance at the water hole, but at some point, they mean to make a meal of their water hole neighbours. And when doing so, many species create associations with others of their kind to hunt.

This, too, is true of humans. Most of humanity seeks to live in a spirit of cooperation with others.

In the countryside, people erect walls and fences to establish boundaries, then find it expedient to respect such divisions in order to live in peace. Even in cities, people who live cheek by jowl in the same building respect each other's privacy for the most part. Even if they do not become friends, they either remain polite or ignore each other. Although there are always exceptions, for the most part, mankind behaves in a manner that is based upon "getting along." He might argue with others, but for the most part, he understands that cooperation generally should be the objective, as it's in his best interests. But why, then, are we seeing in so many of the countries of the First World, a [rapidly increasing polarity](#) amongst people. Ms. Starr is exactly correct. Those who would be most inclined toward mutual tolerance have, in recent years, become so polarised that they cannot so much as get together with their own families for the holidays without getting into heated arguments.

Why are people of today so solidly in one of two camps?

Can this be blamed on the rise of the internet? Well, no, the internet has become the source of a plethora of opinions and perceptions. And more than closing people off to polarised "A" and "B" choices, the internet has served to broaden public discourse. Of course, most people express distrust for the media, particularly those networks that purportedly deal in "news." What passes for news today is far from objective information that the viewer can then assess at his leisure.

On one network, we view unceasing diatribes against one political party. Then we turn the channel and view unceasing diatribes against the opposing party.

In turning on the News, we arrive at Indoctrination Central.

But if we really pay attention objectively, we discover that the same programmes are dictating to us that it is either our humanitarian duty to vax, or that vaxxing will enslave us to globalists who will inject us with microchips.

They are also our source for the opposing beliefs that warfare is essential to protect us against those who seek to destroy us, or that it will be the wars themselves that will destroy us.

In fact, all of Ms. Starr's concerns find their source in the media. When we ask the question, "Who is shaking the jar... and why?" we find that those who control the media are at the source of the polarisation of people, especially in the First World.

As to the "Why?" the answer is so simple that it's often overlooked. Like the ants, the more a people can be made to fight each other, the easier it is to subjugate them.

And since the effort to polarise people has become so massive, we can only conclude that the ultimate objective will be to implement a *far* greater level of subjugation, in an abnormally short period of time.

Liberal vs. Conservative. Black vs. white. Man vs. woman. Divide and conquer.

In such a socio-political climate, the challenge will be to keep your wits about you. As the jar is shaken on a daily basis, it will be vital to recognise that those who control the media are creating a war between the pigs and the wildebeests. This is something that is not desired by either species, but as Hermann Goering stated, "Why, of course the people

don't want war." They must be goaded into it if those who are pulling the stings are to achieve greater subjugation.

In the coming years, this trend can be expected to become far worse than at present. The challenge will be to escape the jar if you can. Find a location where the state of warfare is less pronounced, or if this is not possible, seek a location within the jar that's away from the fray.

Those who fall for the bait – who buy into rabidly supporting one political party or another, or who allow themselves to be angered at an entire race, or who are conned into hatred of an entire gender – will prove to be the greatest casualties of subjugation.

# The Shutdown Show



The government “shutdown” is a show, of course – because the government hasn’t actually shut down. All that’s happened, mainly, is a show of some recipients of government checks not receiving them. The money that finances these checks continues to be collected (via taxes) or created *ex nihilo* – via the “Fed,” that entity that the banking cartel created to run the government.

People who work outside the government – who earn rather than take their living – cannot tell that the government has “shut down” because they are still having to pay the taxes that the government redistributes to those who take rather than earn their living; they are still having to comply with the laws and regulations imposed by the government. 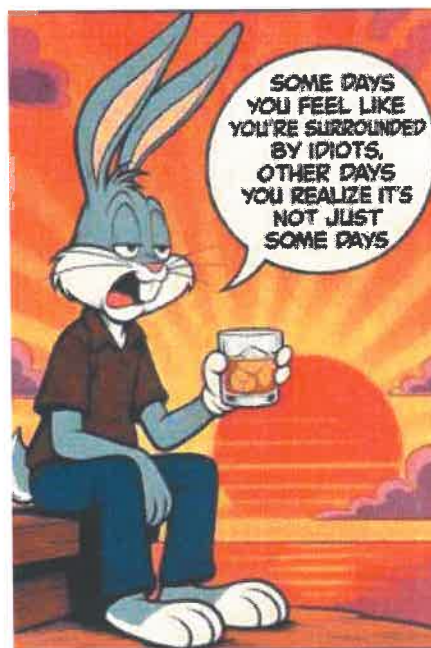
*Of course* he supports *reasonable* things; what *reasonable* person would not?

# Charlie Kirk, Epstein, and the Zionist Cabal

Sure, it may sound like that's not an America First thing, but what do I know? I've never owned a single MAGA hat.

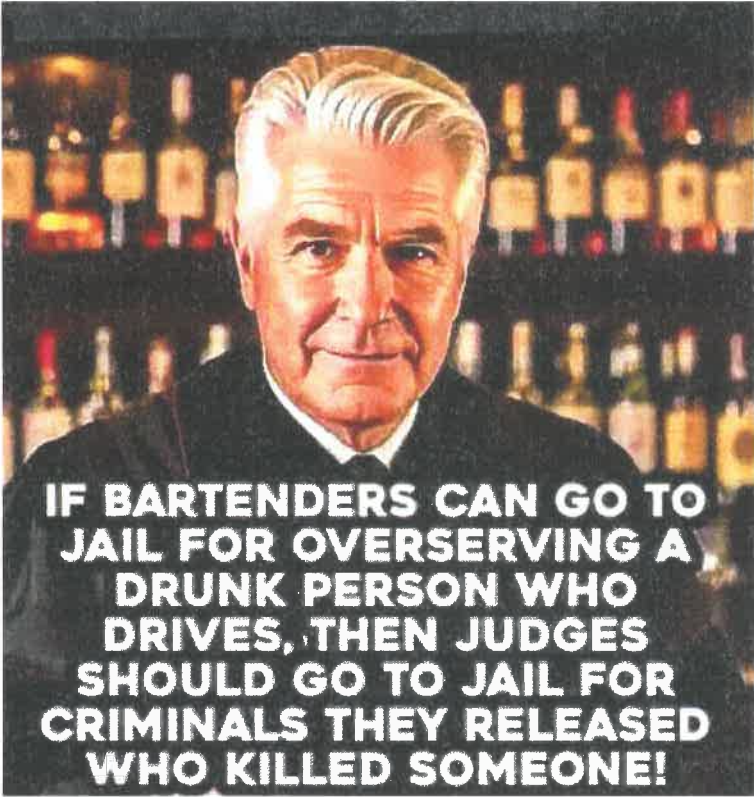

### Sizing Up Trump

Approaching a year since Trump's third election as president, how do we sum him up?

He has done good things. He has closed the border. He is attempting to deport some of the many millions of illegal immigrants that the Democrats brought into our country. He freed the January 6 protesters framed by a totally corrupt Biden regime "Justice" Department and a whore media. He is attempting to dislodge the DEI that has replaced merit throughout US society including the military. He has taken steps to reduce the anti-Americanism of the enormous federal bureaucracy and to stop the weaponization of law against Americans who have traditional American values. Clearly, the area cannot be both a refuge and an area of oil and gas exploitation.

Environmentalists wonder how long before a bankrupt US government sells the national forests to timber companies. In his attack on Venezuela, Trump uses the claim of a war against drugs as a cover for a war to overthrow a country and resume US exploitation of its resources, just as George W. Bush used "the war on terror" to overthrow Arab states for Israel. What is the evidence that small craft in Venezuelan and international waters are loaded with drugs on the way to the US? How can any evidence be found when the boats are blown up and destroyed instead of boarded and inspected. What authority does the US have for boarding boats in Venezuelan and international waters? Trump's policy is to destroy the craft and the people on them on suspicion alone without evidence or authority. If US police acted this way in the US they would be arrested for murder.

A government cannot legally execute people without conviction for a capital crime. If there are Venezuelan drug runners, what is the evidence that they are connected to the government? How likely is it that Venezuela, which has been on Washington's target list for years, would provide Washington with a drug excuse to overthrow the government and install a regime of its own?

The likelihood is that Trump is going to have America at war with Russia, Iran, Venezuela, China, and all who refuse to obey his orders.

As much as Americans needed Trump's accomplishments, his failures are a large price to pay. America needs a strong president, because leadership requires strength. Leadership also requires moral and mutually acceptable solutions, not orders imposed by coercion. Trump does not own the world, and he cannot impose dictates on Russia, Iran, India, and China. Something is amiss that the Trump regime cannot see that this is an unsuccessful and dangerous policy.

## Sizing Up Putin

Among Western foreign policy commentators there seems to be confusion about Putin and Peskov's insistence that Russia remains committed to the Alaska agreement. What Putin and Peskov understand the Alaska meeting to have accomplished is obtaining Trump's agreement that ending the conflict in Ukraine has to begin with resolving the conflict the West has chosen to have with Russia. What Putin means by the root cause of the conflict is the hostile attitude in the West toward Russia. It is this hostile attitude that brought NATO with US missile bases to Russia's border, overthrew the Russian friendly Ukraine government, attacked the Russian population of Donbas and forced Russia's military intervention. Most Western commentators continue to lie between their teeth that Russia is responsible for starting the conflict in Ukraine when it is clear that the West forced the Russian intervention. To force Russian intervention was the entire purpose of the Maidan Revolution in 2014 and subsequent deception of Russia with the Minsk Agreement, which turned out not to be an agreement.

In the Alaska meeting Putin concluded that Trump agreed that the root cause is the absence of a mutual security agreement denied to Putin by the Biden Regime, NATO, and the EU in January 2022, thus provoking the Russian intervention in Ukraine. First the root cause was to be addressed and then the cease fire. Putin was not agreeable to a cease fire that would result in Ukrainian forces being rebuilt while negotiations went nowhere.

As John Helmer and I pointed out, the Alaska understanding is inconsistent with Washington's foreign policy goal of hegemony and with the expectation of billions of dollars in commissions to Western political figures from the sales to Europe of American weapons to continue the war in Ukraine. With Trump's success in getting Europe to increase defense budgets to 5% of GDP, commission payouts gleam in the eyes of Western government officials.

The controlling interests in the West is for the conflict to continue. Trump's "advisors" got this through to him, and Trump suddenly cancelled his meeting with Putin and changed his tune yet again. Now his tune is again that the killing has to stop first with a cease fire, and then the negotiations can begin. This, of course, serves no Russian interests except those of Putin's "advisor," Kirill Dmitriev, a spokesman for Russian business interests whose connections are in the West and not with BRICS. Dmitriev wants Putin to give up, as does Putin's central bank director, so that American-Russian

business interests can be mended and the profitable connections of Russian businesses with the West can be restored.

Why Putin relies on self-interested Kirill Dmitriev and pro-American central bank director Elvira Nabiullina, who set up \$300 billion in Russian assets to be frozen and now possibly used to fund Ukraine's continuation of the war for another three years, I do not know. It strikes me as the worst possible judgement by a leader who is trying to avoid WW 3.

Why Trump relies on Witcoff and Kellogg is equally puzzling. It is extraordinary that the two leaders who, we hope, are working to avoid WW 3, are relying on "advisors" who are working against them.

My conclusion is that money and US hegemony are more important than avoiding war. So it is likely we will get war.

Like John Helmer and myself, Gilbert Doctorow is outside the box of the official narrative. This means that the three of us are subjected to name-calling instead of engagement with our analysis. It is OK with me if I can be shown to be wrong—indeed, I would be glad of it as my conclusion is depressing—and I assume Helmer and Doctorow feel the same. Those few of us who are outside the box cannot afford to have thin skin.

Doctorow has raised the issue of how much longer Putin can hold to his hopes that Trump will flip back to the Alaska agreement between the two world leaders and perhaps this time stay there. Resolving the conflict is a far better solution than a major war certain to turn nuclear. To be clear, Doctorow, Helmer, and I admire Putin for his effort to avoid war. He is clearly a moral and humane person, unlike the money-grabbers in the West who put their profits ahead of the survival of humanity. When Doctorow says Putin shows cowardice, perhaps he means that this is the way Putin appears to the US, UK, and Europe. In other words, Putin's good intentions are working against him.

Doctorow, who watches the state controlled Russian TV programs on which the war and foreign policy are discussed and who is currently in Moscow looking into the evolving attitude toward the war as best as he can, has noticed a growing impatience with the way Putin has been conducting the war for nearly four years. In foreign policy circles, if not within Putin's own circle, the futility of attempting to negotiate with the West and Washington is recognized. Among Russian populations, their life is increasingly disrupted by long-range drone attacks that disrupt GPS service, airline flights, internet service, and prevent businesses from completing sales transactions, and there are the occasional civilian deaths far from the battlefield.

The rising criticism of Putin's conduct of the war in foreign policy circles and the public reached a new level, Doctorow reports, when the main TV news analysis program's host said that negotiations had failed and it was time to "destroy Ukraine" and quickly end the war. The deputy Russian foreign minister agreed as did, it seems, Lavrov, both of whom were contradicted by Kremlin spokesman Peskov. The program's host is a

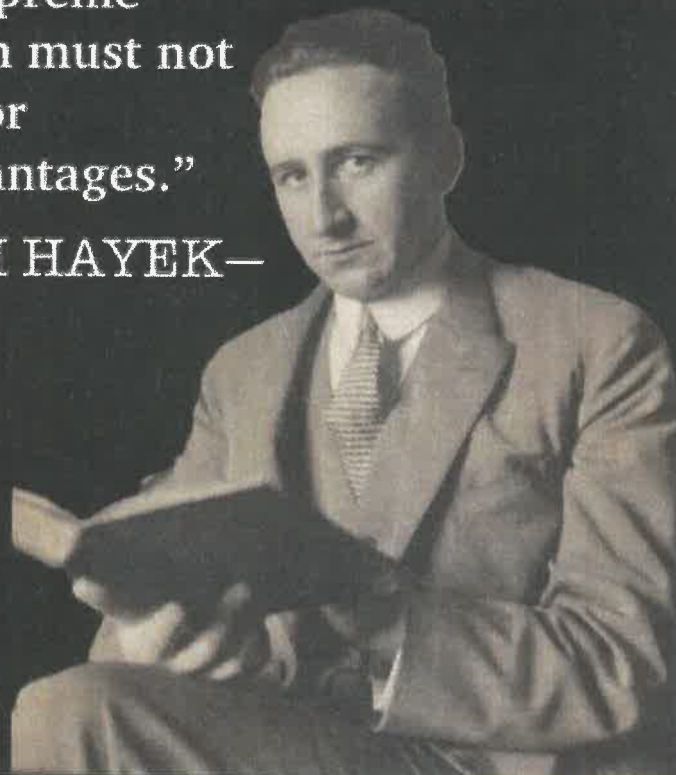
protege of the director of Russian state TV. Neither he nor the deputy prime minister would have risked taking such positions unless there was much support behind them.

Why the contradiction by Peskov as the TV host and deputy foreign minister are obviously correct? The answer, it seems, is that Putin is holding on to hopes too long. A conflict that should have had a victorious conclusion for Russia within a matter of weeks is now almost 4 years long. The four long years are marred with endless undefended red lines that have convinced the West that Putin can be knuckled under. Consequently, the war has ever widened. Putin's misjudgment is turning a limited conflict into a world war.

Here I will state the root cause of the problem as clearly as it can be stated for both Americans and policy-makers in Washington and Europe and for Russians and the Kremlin. War is profitable for the Western military-security complex. Ending conflict hurts those who profit from it, as President Eisenhower warned Americans in 1961. The doctrine of US hegemony expressed by the Wolfowitz Doctrine when the Soviet Union collapsed, thus removing the only constraint on US hegemony, is still operative. This doctrine allied with money interests is the basis for Washington's hostility toward Russia. The Wolfowitz Doctrine and the profits of war are the obstacles to ending the root cause of the conflict.

One camp sees endless corruption on the Left, while ignoring the constant and detestable corruption of the Right. The other obsesses over the disgusting policies of the Left while ignoring the despotic nature of the Right. Both are right. And both are blind.

Because the system isn't hiding corruption anymore—it's selectively leaking it. Controlled exposure fractures collective outrage. What used to unite people now splits them apart. If only one team sees the abuse, the abuser keeps power.

And when you're this divided, you're not going to overthrow anything. You're going to spend all your energy owning your neighbor while the machine tightens the screws.

### **When Conspiracies Come True, But No One Cares**

Over the past few years, countless so-called “conspiracy theories” have turned out to be true—or at least disturbingly close. Government surveillance, censorship partnerships with tech companies, media manipulation, pharma corruption, an elite cabal of child traffickers, bio lab leaks, digital currency control—all once laughed off as tinfoil fodder, now quietly confirmed by mainstream reports.

And still, nothing changes.

Because the public doesn't process truth as truth anymore. We process it through tribal filters. If it confirms your side's bias, you'll care. If it doesn't, you'll ignore it—or worse, call it disinformation. The ruling class knows this. It's not a bug. It's the whole damn system.

As long as we're psychologically at war with each other, they never have to worry about us questioning power itself.

### **History Repeats—Because It's Allowed To**

Authoritarian regimes have long employed division to consolidate their control. In the 20th century, tyrants used class, race, religion, and ideology to fragment resistance. They encouraged informants, snitches, and neighbor-vs-neighbor surveillance. Once people turn on each other, the boot doesn't even need to stomp. # Dad Sues Abortionist for Killing Two of His Children in Abortions

A Texas man is suing a California doctor, [claiming that the doctor mailed abortion pills to his girlfriend, violated state and federal law, and caused the wrongful death of his two unborn children.](#)

According to the [complaint](#) against Dr. Remy Coeytaux, filed July 20, Jerry Rodriguez is seeking an injunction to stop the doctor from distributing abortion drugs in Texas on behalf of “all current and future fathers of unborn children in the United States.” Rodriguez also seeks \$75,000 in damages.

Rodriguez filed the suit after his girlfriend took abortion drugs on two separate occasions to end two pregnancies. The complaint alleges that Rodriguez’s girlfriend became pregnant with his child in July 2024 and planned to keep the baby. Her estranged husband, from whom she had legally separated but not yet divorced, wanted her to abort the baby and ordered abortion drugs from Coeytaux in September.

The husband then gave the drugs to Rodriguez’s girlfriend and both he and the woman’s mother allegedly pressured her into taking them. She was more than 10 weeks pregnant at the time. The Food and Drug Administration has approved the abortion drugs mifepristone and misoprostol for use within the first 10 weeks of a pregnancy.

According to the complaint, the woman again became pregnant with Rodriguez’s child in October, and again planned to keep the baby. However, she proceeded with a

medication abortion a second time at her husband's house in January, even though she was nearly three months pregnant.

The woman is now pregnant for the third time, but the complaint states that Rodriguez fears she will be pressured to have an abortion once more.

The *Daily Citizen* [reported](#) that Rodriguez alleges that Coeytaux caused the wrongful death of his two children and committed “wrongful acts” by violating Texas law regarding chemical abortions. Under the Texas Health and Safety Code, only Texas-licensed physicians may provide abortion drugs to pregnant women, and only after following specific protocol, such as performing an ultrasound before an abortion is carried out. Abortion is also a felony in Texas, except in cases when the mother's life is in danger or her health is substantially harmed.

Rodriguez's complaint also alleges that Coeytaux violated a rarely enforced 1873 federal law known as the Comstock Act, which bans the mailing of “obscene” materials, including materials related to abortion.

According to the *Daily Citizen*, the case is the first to challenge — in federal court — shield laws that protect abortion providers from out-of-state investigations.

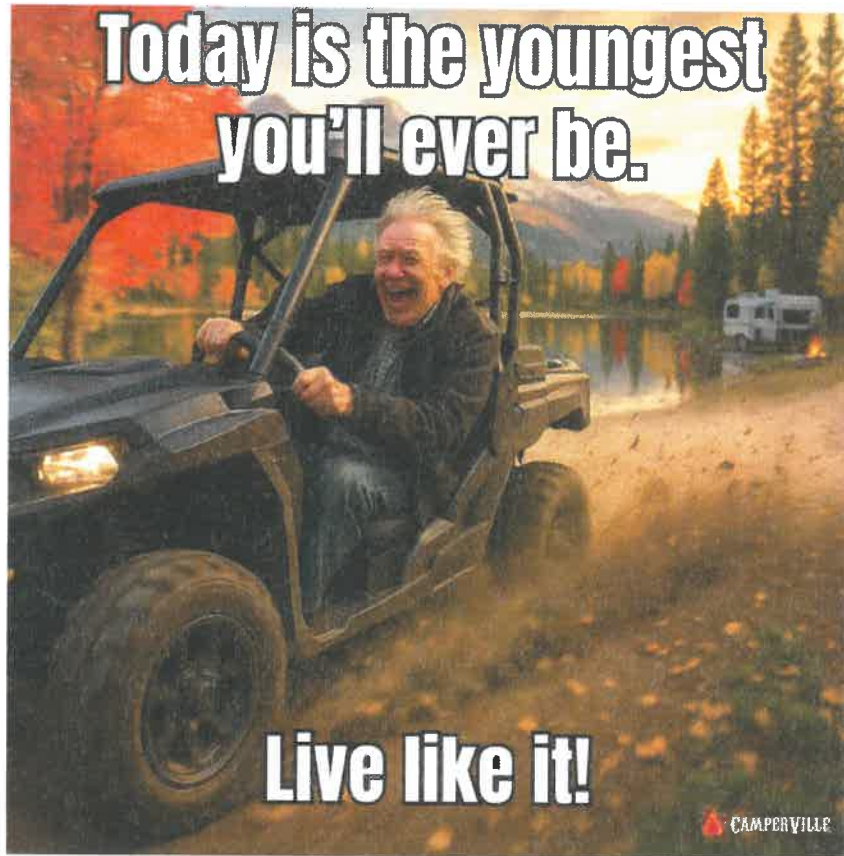

# Blue In the Face

Well, I guess it's official: I'm now "blue in the face." The kind of blue that frustrated people get when they've said something so many times, they say they've done it 'til they're "blue in the face."

Recently, I received an email from someone who reads my commentaries on one of the many online platforms that republishes my messages from *Wisconsin Christian News* and our radio broadcasts. This is someone who contacts me frequently, always starting out telling me how they enjoyed my message and agreed with most of it, but then spends another fifteen minutes telling me how I missed the mark. Don't get me wrong; I can certainly take criticism, and believe me, I get more than my fair share. I don't claim to be infallible, and the messages I write are not always inclusive, because space only allows me to cover so many aspects of any particular topic.

Most recently, my critic accused me of "never" telling people the vital solution to America's problems. I was told that I'm correct about identifying and calling out the critical issues our society suffers from, but that I "*never*" offer the solution. This is a common correspondence I receive from this person. They correct me weekly — no matter what I'm writing or talking about — and even when I *do* address the specific solutions this person is so insistent about, I never seem to do it to their satisfaction.

So, this past week, I wrote back that I do, in fact, address exactly their concerns, frequently. I *have*, in fact, written and spoken extensively about the particular areas of Scripture they feel are most vitally important. And I agree with them. What they brought up *is* the solution we're all searching for. But I've covered these things so often, I feel I've done it "til I'm blue in the face," yet, somehow, they've missed all those articles. Maybe because they never bother to visit our website: [WisconsinChristianNews.com](http://WisconsinChristianNews.com), subscribe to our newspaper or get to know what our mission here is all about. They only read *other* websites — the ones that *republish* my articles, but some of which only publish the ones dealing with secular matters, and not spiritual ones.

But again, this person is correct about the solution. And although I've done it so often, I feel I've written and spoken on these things "til I'm blue in the face," I'm going to do it again here, because many of you have also, somehow, missed the importance of the solution to all our problems. I *know* many have missed it, based on the responses I receive after radio broadcasts. I get a lot more response from people requesting transcripts or audio CDs to read or listen to again — or share with others — when I discuss things related to politics, government, Globalism, or frightening things now manifesting on the earth. But when I speak on *spiritual* matters, it seems like no one's listening.

Perhaps because my readers and listeners believe they already know all this. But it's one thing to have head knowledge and another thing to actually *do* something about it. Case in point: I've heard 2 Chronicles 7:14 recited so many times, by well-meaning Christians, who understand this is the answer we're so desperately seeking as a nation — but I don't think I've ever heard about anyone actually trying to implement what this verse calls us to do. Let's read it:

*"If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."* The trouble is, most professing Christians don't think this applies to them. But it specifically applies to them! Our Heavenly Father is specifically saying, *"If My people..."* That means us — those who claim the name of Christ.

I believe if we call ourselves "Christians," we'd better be sure we're not taking that sacred Name in vain. What does this verse call God's people to do? 1) Humble themselves. That's a hard pill to swallow for so many church-goers. After all, they're doing their duty. They attend church every week — some are there every time the doors are open. They're involved, active in their local church. They give their money to the church, and believe they have it all together.

They're saved by grace. But are they humble? Are they teachable? Or do they think they already know all there is to know about Our Creator and His commands? Do they survive on assumed "grace," telling themselves that "no one is perfect and God will

certainly forgive all my past and future sins; and my continued hidden sins are under the grace of the blood of the Lamb?"

Try to dig deeper into the Word of God, or push to take Scripture literally, and urge faithful church-goers to even make *an attempt* to follow the commands of God, and you'll quickly find out how UNhumble they really are.

2) Do we pray and seek God's face? And by that I mean, do we have an insatiable desire to have a close relationship with our Father, through His Son Jesus, led by the Holy Spirit? Or when we pray, do we just take our "wish list" to "Daddy," offer up quick, vain, meaningless prayers for ourselves and others — "telling" God what we want, rather than conversing with Him, drawing near to Him...like a child?

I frustrate people when I'm asked to lead corporate prayer, because I don't pray like most of the "professional Christians" do when they're on stage. If you ask me to lead group prayer, it's not going to be what you're used to. Because most people are used to short, concise, quick "prayers" that sound spiritual but have no depth, and leave no room for any real, personal impact. When I pray, I talk to God, then I listen for His response. Then I reply and listen some more. I don't make a speech. It's a conversation, and I believe that's how prayer should be. That's what "seeking His face" means.

3). Turn from our wicked ways. Most professing Christians don't believe they have any wicked ways to turn from. They have an attitude of superiority over the fallen, lost sinners they encounter on the streets every day. This gets back to the aspect of humility. We all need to humble ourselves every day before Almighty God, grateful for what He's done for us. But we'll never get there if we never get honest with ourselves, pray and truly seek His face.

Most believe they're basically "good" people. "Good" Christians. Romans 3:10-12, *"There is none righteous, no, not one. There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one."* Psalm 14:3, *"They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one."* Jeremiah 17:9, *"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked:*

*who can know it?" Isaiah 53:6, "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all."*

Rather than being haughty and smug about our position in Christ, we need to humble ourselves, pray and seek His face, not just acknowledging we're not "perfect," but also turning from our wicked ways. And our prayer should be that of Psalm 139: 23 & 24, *"Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts, and see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."*

Our goal should be Romans 12:2, *"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."*

Our world today has millions of man-made laws. We struggle under a burden of rules and regulations, judicial decrees, unjust mandates, federal, state and county laws and local ordinances. Millions of them.

But God gave us just ten. Ten simple commands to follow. Can you imagine what the world would be like if we even attempted to follow those Ten Commandments? And here's a challenge for you: if you're one of those "faithful" church-goers, can you even tell me what those simple Ten Commandments are, without having to look them up? (You'll find them in Exodus 20). 1) Have no other gods before Yahweh, the one and only true God. 2) Don't make idols and worship them. 3) Don't take the Lord's name in vain. 4) Remember the Sabbath and keep it holy. 5) Honor your father and mother. 6) Don't commit murder. 7) Don't commit adultery. 8) Don't steal. 9) Don't gossip, lie about others or bear false witness. And 10) Don't covet. In other words, don't jealously desire what someone else has.

Now, I've written and spoken for years about the importance of God's Ten Commandments until I've become "blue in the face." Ten seemingly simple commandments, yet we've all broken all ten of them, if not in deed, at least in our hearts, which is equally damning. The fact that most Christians can't even name all ten in a row shows how casually we regard our so-called "Christian faith." We should be ashamed, and this should lead to us humbling ourselves, praying and truly seeking God's face, turning from our wicked ways.

Is that what's happening? Of course not. We smugly recite 2 Chronicles 7;14, but have no intention of ever stirring the Body of Christ to come up with an action plan which would revive a dying, dead and outright apostate so-called "Church." Most don't even have any real intention of doing any of this in their own individual lives.

Yes, we are saved by grace, by the blood of the Lamb, through humble repentance and faith. But that repentance isn't a one-time "sinner's prayer." That confession is only the beginning of a lifetime of sanctification. We're to be transformed by the renewing of our minds, yet most of us, even Christians, remain complacent, apathetic and conformed to this world.

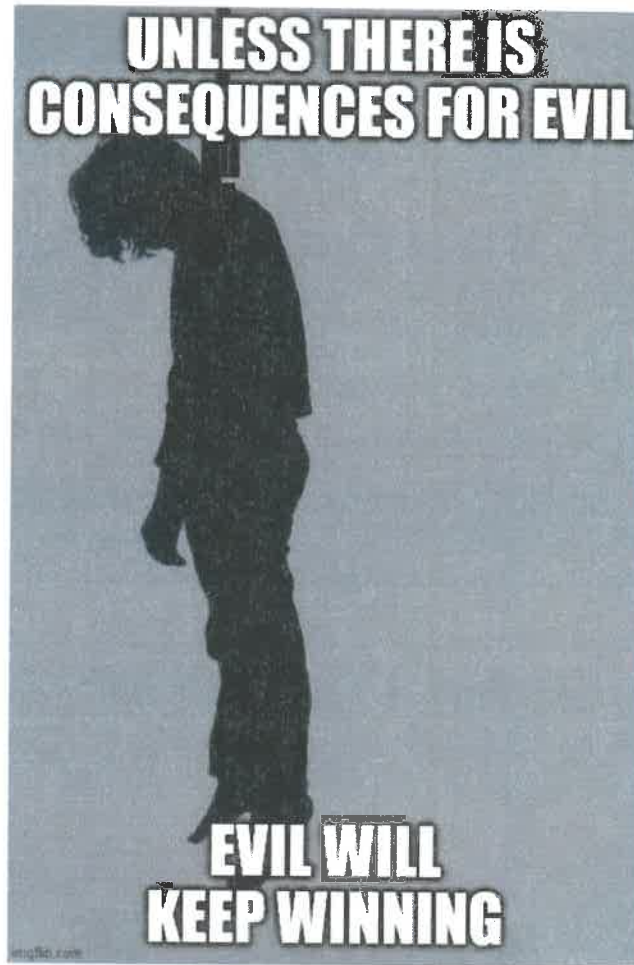

# Our Society Has Produced A “Lost Generation” That Doesn’t Have Any Hope

*The reading and math scores of 12th graders have plunged to their lowest level in over 20 years.*

*The scores, part of a test from the National Assessment of Education Progress, showed the average reading score for 12th graders dropped to the lowest level since the NAEP first administered the reading assessment in 1992. The average score for 12th graders in math in 2024 was the lowest since 2005, when the math assessment framework changed significantly.*

I went to public schools all the way through high school, and then I attended two public universities for a total of eight years.

The quality of the education that I received was a joke.

The entire system is a fraud! It is about time that we all finally admit that the emperor doesn't have any clothes on.

But what our public schools are good at is indoctrinating young minds. For example, just consider what has been happening in the state of Maryland...

*Schools are subverting students' mental health by endlessly hectoring them to doubt or despise their own bodies. These school antics reached epidemic level even before the start of the Covid pandemic. In 2019, the state of Maryland issued regulations to promote "viewing each student's" "gender identity and expression" as "valuable." Montgomery County, the largest school system in the state, announced*

*that it would choose books for the curriculum “through an ‘LGBTQ+ Lens’ and ask whether books ‘reinforced or disrupted’ ‘stereotypes,’ ‘cisnormativity,’ and ‘power hierarchies,’” according to a brief filed at the Supreme Court by parents who successfully challenged the school system. That brief also noted that “teachers are told to frame disagreement with [pro-LGBTQ] ideas as ‘hurtful,’ and to counter with examples of ‘men who paint their nails’ or ‘wear dresses.’” The goal is to instill in children “a new perspective not easily contravened by their parents,” as the county school board admitted.*

*The indoctrination produced a 582% increase in the number of kids self-identifying as “non-binary” in Montgomery County schools. “Disrupting children’s thinking” has been so successful that almost half of the students identified themselves as non-binary.*

Sadly, most parents have no idea what is really going on in these schools.

They just assume that their kids are being prepared for life in the real world.

But instead they are having leftist “values” systematically shoved down their throats.

Needless to say, it gets even worse at the next level.

Our colleges and universities are completely and utterly dominated by radical leftists.

This is why so many of our young people abandon the values that they were raised with once they enroll in these “institutions of higher learning”. This is a point that was made exceptionally well in a recent article by Victor Davis Hanson...

*Hundreds of thousands of students emerge from campuses not just indoctrinated with contempt for the Western tradition and American exceptionalism, and not just often thousands of dollars in debt from inflated tuition, but also poorly educated by the standards that once defined education.*

*The working classes and high school graduates, supposedly the losers of our society, are not those who are dividing the country. They are not often advocating violence or trying to use any means necessary to overturn the established order.*

*But so often the products of the modern university are doing just that.*

*Sadly, in all these recent horrors, the ideology behind them—the premise that either birthed or appeased them—was birthed in modern higher education.*

He is right.

Once upon a time, colleges and universities were primarily concerned with equipping students with the skills that they would need for their future careers.

Today, colleges and universities are primarily concerned with brainwashing impressionable young kids.

So how is that working out for our society?

Well, we now have a raging epidemic of loneliness among our young people...

*Half of U.S. youth say that loneliness has a daily disruptive impact on their mental health, according to Hopelab and Data For Progress survey results shared exclusively with Axios.*

In addition, the percentage of the population that is suffering with or receiving treatment for depression has nearly doubled over the past decade...

*Depression remains an ongoing problem in the U.S. as historically high rates persist, polling company Gallup reveals.*

*The reported percentage of U.S. adults suffering or receiving treatment for depression has been higher than 18 percent for the past two years. A decade ago, in 2015, the number was just over 10 percent.*

*“The increase is alarming, and it is important that we keep an open mind and explore all possible causes for the rapid, and apparently sustained, rise in depression rates over the past decade,” Dr. Gerard Sanacora, a professor of psychiatry, director of Yale Depression Research Program and co-director of Yale New Haven Hospital Interventional Psychiatry Service at Yale University, told Newsweek.*

On top of everything else, “deaths of despair” caused by alcohol abuse, drug abuse and suicide are absolutely soaring...

*Two non-profits, Trust for America’s Health and Well Being Trust, published a report this month which paints a harrowing picture of reality for millennials with an addiction in the United States. According to the report, which is an analysis of data from the CDC, millennials are the most likely age demographic to die from alcohol, drug abuse, and suicide. Millennials are most often defined as people who were born between the years 1981 and 1996, although some definitions expand the category to cover people who were born up through the year 2000.*

*Over the course of one decade, from 2007 to 2017, the rate of alcohol-related deaths among millennials rose by 69%, the rate of deaths caused by drugs rose by 108%, and the suicide rate rose by 35%. The report also indicates that the opioid epidemic has devastated millennials. From 1999 to 2017, the rate of fatal opioid overdoses among millennials rose by 500% and the rate of fatal overdoses involving synthetic opioids (especially fentanyl) skyrocketed by 6,000%.*

Please go back and look at those numbers one more time.

What we are doing is clearly not working.

We have a system that does not give our young people any hope, and the consequences have been absolutely devastating.

Those of us that refuse to go along with the system are increasingly being marginalized and pushed to the fringes of our society, but we will not yield because we have found hope in Jesus Christ. # “Israel Did It; Prove Me Wrong”

The title of this column is the same as the title of a video analysis of the murder of Charlie Kirk on the [Macintosh Team YouTube channel](#). Here is a transcription of that video along with my comments.

Everybody wants to know: Did Israel kill Charlie Kirk?

“No, no, no, don't be ridiculous. A lone gunman did it.”

Always a lone gunman.

“A young man, unstable, angry, looking for attention. His own father turned him in; case closed.”

That's the script. That's the headline. That's the truth we're all supposed to swallow. Neat, tidy, packaged, ready to go.

But here's the problem: Neat and tidy almost never means true. Every time the story is wrapped up this quickly, you should start sniffing for smoke.

And sure enough, the moment Kirk's body was cold, the whispers began: “Israel. Could Israel have had a hand in this?”

“Absurd,” they said. “Insane,” they said. “Stupid.”

Netanyahu himself had to go on live television to shout it down. And if you saw that interview, you know exactly what I'm talking about. He wasn't calm. He wasn't confident. He was flustered, defensive, repeating himself like a man who knows the rumor cuts too close to the bone.

And here's the kicker: On paper, it makes no sense.

Charlie Kirk was Israel's guy. He spent years worshiping at their altar. He told students, “Palestinians don't exist.” He smeared critics as radicals, spread their propaganda, flew on their trips, cashed their donors' checks. He said Israel was America's best friend over and over. He was loyal.

But loyalty in this game doesn't mean forever. Loyalty means obedience. And the second you step out of line, you're not a loyal ally anymore. You're a

liability.

And Charlie Kirk—America's loudest campus Zionist—made the fatal mistake of asking questions. Epstein? Mossad? October 7th? Gaza? He started inviting Tucker Carlson and Megyn Kelly on stage. He started letting Dave Smith call Gaza what it really is: the slaughter of a captive people. And that was it. The alarms went off. Donors flipped. Zionist bloggers.

And now watch what happens: The media points left; the right points back. Social media collapses into chaos. Everyone's screaming at everyone else: "Deep State. MAGA. Antifa. CIA." No one agrees. No one unites. No one looks at the one country that always benefits from division: Israel.

Because while Americans lose their minds over Charlie Kirk, Israel is still in Gaza, still bombing, still starving children, still bulldozing homes. Business as usual.

That's the genius of it. They don't even have to deny it convincingly. Netanyahu just shrugs and says, "Stupid. Absurd." And that's enough. Because the real trick isn't to prove innocence. It's to stir the pot so no one cares. And boy, did it work.

So, let's ask the old Latin question: *Cui bono?* Who benefits? Not the shooter. Not his father. Not America. The people who benefit are the same people who always benefit. The same people who suddenly don't have to worry about 3,500 campus chapters shifting against them. The same people who saw Kirk's hesitation as a threat. Because if Charlie Kirk, their golden boy, could doubt, then every conservative student in America could doubt too. That's the nightmare scenario.

And what happened right after his death? Shapiro stepped up, ready with his new tour. Donors stopped complaining. *Turning Point USA* suddenly had new handlers. The machine didn't miss a beat. The blood wasn't even dry before the replacement program was rolling.

But hey, remember: It was a lone gunman. Always a lone gunman.

Isn't it amazing how the lone gunman always seems to clear the field for the most powerful people alive? Kennedy, King, Malcolm, now Kirk. Just random nobodies with perfect timing, doing the dirty work history demands. "Nothing suspicious here."

And while Americans rage at each other, left versus right, MAGA versus woke, CIA versus Deep State, Israel carries on like nothing happened.

Bombing hospitals, cutting off water, starving [people].

I love the line: “No one looks at the one country that always benefits from division: Israel.”

Israel is a pariah state that only exists to destroy every Gentile nation it can via sowing division and chaos within those countries. Every goy killed by another goy is a goy that Zionist Jews don’t need to spend money killing.

1. The official FBI narrative is impossible to believe. I am absolutely convinced that the killing could not have happened the way they said it happened.
2. I am absolutely convinced that the 22-year-old kid did not shoot Charlie Kirk.
3. I am absolutely convinced that Kirk was not shot with a .30-06 caliber rifle.
4. I am absolutely convinced that Charlie Kirk's killing was a professional assassination.

And when it comes to professional assassinations, the State of Israel is the uncontested world leader. It is purely natural that millions of Americans believe in their gut that Israel killed Charlie Kirk. More than anyone else, Israel had motive, means and opportunity.

The Iranian consulate in Damascus, Syria, was attacked by Israel, killing many diplomats and negotiators. April 2024

Ali Shamkhani — Israel's large-scale military attack on Iran targeted and killed this Iranian official who was the chief negotiator leading a committee on nuclear talks with the United States. The peace talks with the United States were arranged by President Donald Trump. June 13, 2025

Gazan negotiators were the target of an Israeli assassination in a residential area in the Qatari capital, Doha. Negotiators were there at the behest of President Donald Trump to discuss Trump's ceasefire proposal. The negotiators survived the attack, but six others, including a Qatari security officer, were killed. September 9, 2025

Israel has also assassinated a host of civilian diplomats, leaders and ordinary citizens in Lebanon and Syria. And don't forget the massive pager attacks that killed and wounded thousands of innocent people—mostly women and children—in Lebanon, Syria, London and other places.

Was it an act of respect or a graphic warning when Benjamin Netanyahu gave Donald Trump a golden **pager** during his visit to the White House? Was it a word of accomplishment or a word of warning when Netanyahu told the 250 Israel-supporting U.S. State legislators who were being wined and dined (and indoctrinated) in Israel, "Do you have cell phones? Do you have cell phones here? You're holding a piece of Israel right there."

Israel has been a violent aggressor/terror state since the day it was created in 1948.

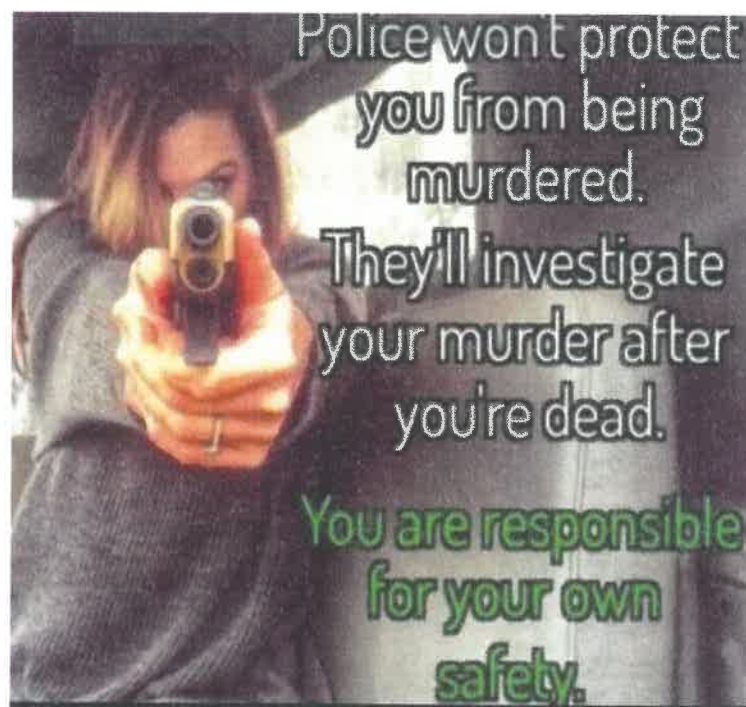
So, answer the questions, yes or no.

# ROMANS 13 RIGHTLY DIVIDED

Remember, Paul wrote Romans while in prison  
For NOT obeying civil authority!

This account of the nature and design of civil government, which is so clearly suggested to us by the plain principles of common sense and reason, is abundantly confirmed by the sacred Scriptures, even by those very texts which have been brought by men of slavish principles to establish the absurd doctrine of unlimited passive obedience and nonresistance, as will abundantly appear by examining the two most noted texts that are commonly brought to support the strange doctrine of passive obedience. The first that I shall cite is in 1 Peter ii. 13, 14: "submit yourselves to every ordinance of man,"--or, rather, as the words ought to be rendered from the Greek, submit yourselves to every human creation, or human constitution,--"for the Lord's sake, whether it be to the king as supreme, or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evil-doers, and for the praise of them that do well." Here we see that the apostle asserts that magistracy is of human creation or appointment; that is, that magistrates have no power or authority but what they derive from the people; that this power they are to exert for the punishment of evil-doers, and for the praise of them that do well; i.e., the end and design of the appointment of magistrates is to restrain wicked men, by proper penalties, from injuring society, and to encourage and honor the virtuous and obedient. Upon this account Christians are to submit to them for the Lord's sake; which is as if he had said, Though magistrates are of mere human appointment, and can claim no power or authority but what they derive from the people, yet, as they are ordained by men to promote the general good by punishing evil-doers and by rewarding and encouraging the virtuous and obedient, you

ought to submit to them out of a sacred regard to the divine authority; for as they, in the faithful discharge of their office, do fulfill the will of God, so ye, by submitting to them, do fulfill the divine command. If the only reason assigned by the apostle why magistrates should be obeyed out of a regard to the divine authority is because they punish the wicked and encourage the good, it follows, that when they punish the virtuous and encourage the vicious we have a right to refuse yielding any submission or obedience to them; i.e., whenever they act contrary to the end and design of their institution, they forfeit their authority to govern the people, and the reason for submitting to them, out of regard to the divine authority, immediately ceases; and they being only of human appointment, the authority which the people gave them the public have a right to take from them, and to confer it upon those who are more worthy. So far is this text from favoring arbitrary principles, that there is nothing in it but what is consistent with and favorable to the highest liberty that any man can wish to enjoy; for this text requires us to submit to the magistrate no further than he is the encourager and protector of virtue and the punisher of vice; and this is consistent with all that liberty which the Deity has bestowed upon us.

The other text which I shall mention, and which has been made use of by the favorers of arbitrary government as their great sheet anchor and main support, is in Rom. xiii., the first six verses: "Let every soul be subject to the higher powers; for there is no power but of God. The powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God; and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation; for rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? Do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: for he is the minister of God to thee for

good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doth evil. Wherefore ye must needs be subject not only for wrath, but also for conscience' sake. For, for this cause pay you tribute also; for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing." A very little attention, I apprehend, will be sufficient to show that this text is so far from favoring arbitrary government, that, on the contrary, it strongly holds forth the principles of true liberty. Subjection to the higher powers is enjoined by the apostle because there is no power but of God; the powers that be are ordained of God; consequently, to resist the power is to resist the ordinance of God: and he repeatedly declares that the ruler is the minister of God. Now, before we can say whether this text makes for or against the doctrine of unlimited passive obedience, we must find out in what sense the apostle affirms that magistracy is the ordinance of God, and what he intends when he calls the ruler the minister of God. Now, if this be the only sense in which the apostle affirms that magistrates are ordained of God as his ministers, resistance must be criminal only so far forth as they are the ministers of God and ceases being criminal when they cease being the ministers of God, i.e., when they act contrary to the general good, and seek to destroy the liberties of the people.

That we have gotten the apostle's sense of magistracy being the ordinance of God, will plainly appear from the text itself for, after having asserted that to resist the power is to resist the ordinance of God, and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation, he immediately adds as the reason of this assertion, "For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? Do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: for he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be



afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doth evil." Here is a plain declaration of the sense in which he asserts that the authority of the magistrate is ordained of God, viz., because rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil; therefore we ought to dread offending them, for we cannot offend them but by doing evil; and if we do evil we have just reason to fear their power; for they bear not the sword in vain, but in this case the magistrate is a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil: but if we are found doers of that which is good, we have no reason to fear the authority of the magistrate; for in this case, instead of being punished, we shall be protected and encouraged. The reason why the magistrate is called the minister of God is because he is to protect, encourage, and honor them that do well, and to punish them that do evil; therefore it is our duty to submit to them, not merely for fear of being punished by them, but out of regard to the divine authority, under which they are deputed to execute judgment and to do justice. For this reason, according to the apostle, tribute is to be paid them, because, as the ministers of God, their whole business is to protect every man in the enjoyment of his just rights and privileges, and to punish every evil-doer.

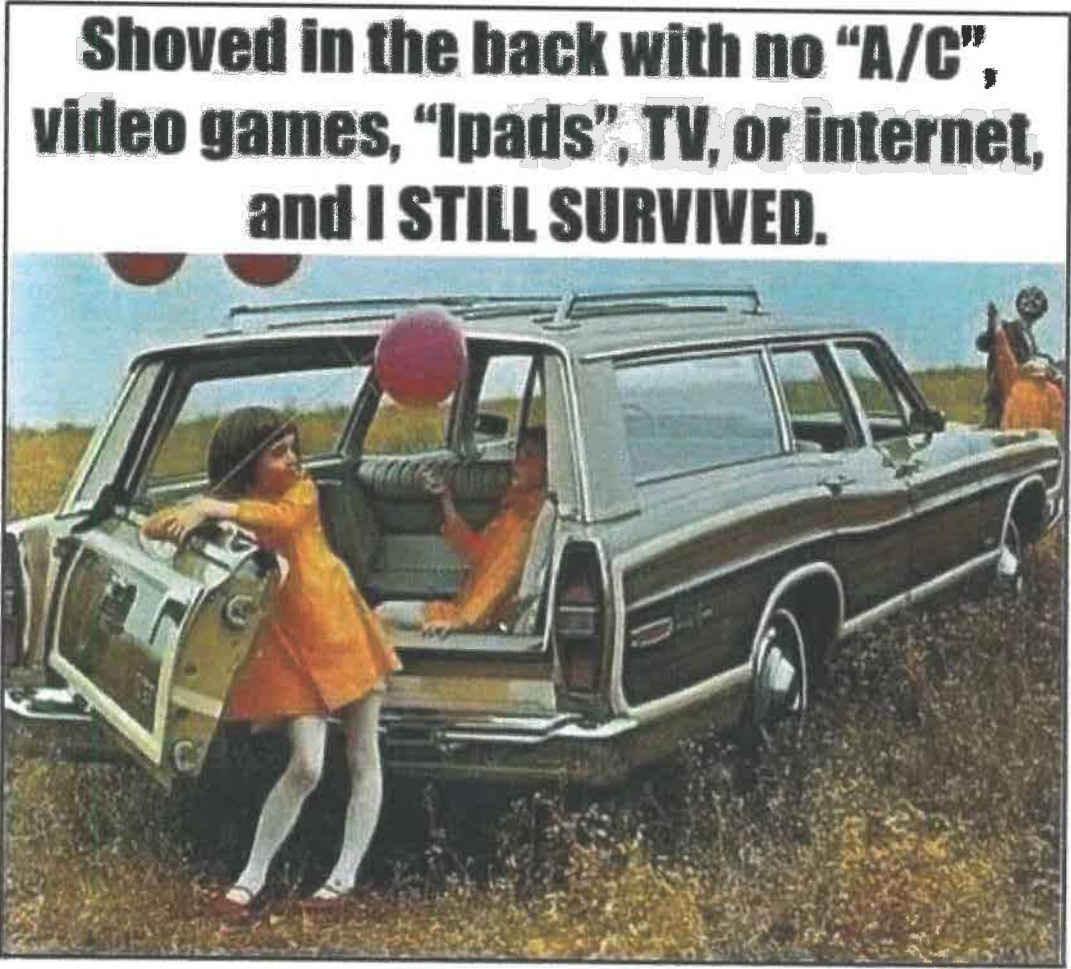
If the apostle, then, asserts that rulers are ordained of God only because they are a terror to evil works and a praise to them that do well; if they are ministers of God only because they encourage virtue and punish vice; if for this reason only they are to be obeyed for conscience' sake; if the sole reason why they have a right to tribute is because they devote themselves wholly to the business of securing to men their just rights, and to the punishing of evil-doers,--it follows, by undeniable consequence, that when they become the pests of human society, when they promote and encourage evil-doers, and become a terror to good works, they then cease

being the ordinance of God; they are no longer rulers nor ministers of God; they are so far from being the powers that are ordained of God that they become the ministers of the powers of darkness, and it is so far from being a crime to resist them, that in many cases it may be highly criminal in the sight of Heaven to refuse resisting and opposing them to the utmost of our power; or, in other words, that the same reasons that require us to obey the ordinance of God, do equally oblige us, when we have power and opportunity, to oppose and resist the ordinance of Satan.

Hence we see that the apostle Paul, instead of being a friend to tyranny and arbitrary government, turns out to be a strong advocate for the just rights of mankind, and is for our enjoying all that liberty with which God has invested us; for no power (according to the apostle) is ordained of God but what is an encourage of every good and virtuous action,-- "Do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same." No man need to be afraid of this power which is ordained of God who does nothing but what is agreeable to the law of God; for this power will not restrain us from exercising any liberty which the Deity has granted us; for the minister of God is to restrain US from nothing but the doing of that which is evil, and to this we have no right. To practise evil is not liberty, but licentiousness. Can we conceive of a more perfect, equitable, and generous plan of government than this which the apostle has laid down, viz., to have rulers appointed over us to encourage us to every good and virtuous action, to defend and protect us in our just rights and privileges, and to grant us everything that can tend to promote our true interest and happiness; to restrain every licentious action, and to punish everyone that would injure or harm us; to become a terror of evil-doers; to make and execute such just and righteous laws as shall effectually deter and hinder men from the commission of

evil, and to attend continually upon this very thing; to make it their constant care and study, day and night, to promote the good and welfare of the community, and to oppose all evil practices? Deservedly may such rulers be called the ministers of God for good. They carry on the same benevolent design towards the community which the great Governor of the universe does towards his whole creation. 'Tis the indispensable duty of a people to pay tribute, and to afford an easy and comfortable subsistence to such rulers, because they are the ministers of God, who are continually laboring and employing their time for the good of the community. He that resists such magistrates does, in a very emphatical sense, resist the ordinance of God; he is an enemy to mankind, odious to God, and justly incurs the sentence of condemnation from the great Judge of quick and dead. Obedience to such magistrates is yielding obedience to the will of God, and, therefore, ought to be performed from a sacred regard to the divine authority. For any one from hence to infer that the apostle enjoins in this text unlimited obedience to the worst of tyrants, and that he pronounces damnation upon those that resist the arbitrary measures of such pests of society, is just as good sense as if one should affirm, that because the Scripture enjoins us obedience to the laws of God, therefore we may not oppose the power of darkness; or because we are commanded to submit to the ordinance of God, therefore we may not resist the ministers of Satan. Such wild work must be made with the apostle before he can be brought to speak the language of oppression! It is as plain, I think, as words can make it, that, according to this text, no tyrant can be a ruler; for the apostle's definition of a ruler is, that he is not a terror to good works, but to the evil; and that he is one who is to praise and encourage those that do well. Whenever, then, the ruler encourages them that do evil, and is a

terror to those that do well,--i.e., as soon as he becomes a tyrant,--he forfeits his authority to govern, and becomes the minister of Satan, and, as such, ought to be opposed.



# Baptist “Pastor” Claims Killing Babies in Abortions is a Good Thing

A recently ordained Baptist minister at a Wisconsin church [has sparked outrage among pro-life advocates](#) by declaring that unborn babies should be killed through abortion to spare them from a world that supposedly “dislikes them because they simply exist.”

Kurt Kaufman, who leads the Federated Church of Green Lake, made the remarks in an interview that surfaced on social media this week, arguing that abortion not only safeguards the mother’s life but also shields children from the trauma of being “forced to be born” into unsupportive homes – even though that’s a false notion.

“Being in favor of reproductive rights, first and foremost, protects the life of the mother, and protects the life of the person that is already living, and is the person that is able to bring more life into this world should they choose,” Kaufman said.

He added: “Furthermore, it protects the life of children. There are so many children that currently exist in this world that were forced to be born because of legislation, because of men that have decided for women, and so as a result, many children have grown up into a unsupportive, unhealthy, and right-challenging household that hasn’t been a life that any child should live. And so being in favor of reproductive choice

helps the life of children everywhere, because they don't have to grow up in a world that dislikes them because they simply exist.”

The interview, shared by the Christian media outlet Protestia on X, has drawn sharp condemnation from pro-life people, who view Kaufman's stance as a direct assault on the inherent dignity of every human life, particularly the most vulnerable — the preborn.

People responding on X highlighted the irony in Kaufman's position, noting his own admission of a traumatic upbringing, yet he's not calling for his own death.

In a separate interview with VoyageDenver, Kaufman described growing up with alcoholic parents, which left him feeling he had to “do it myself” from a young age.

“I grew up with alcoholic parents. This caused me at a young age to come to the understanding that in order for me to do anything, I had to do it myself. I have had to work through this through therapy to come to a new understanding that I have worth on my own outside of any of my accomplishments or work,” he said.

Pro-life people argue that Kaufman's logic would have justified his own abortion, underscoring the flawed premise that human value depends on circumstances or parental readiness. They contend such views echo historical arguments for eugenics, disproportionately targeting minorities, the poor and disabled children, and perpetuate a culture that devalues life from conception.

Pro-life advocates reaffirmed that every child — wanted or not, challenged or thriving — possesses an inalienable right to life. They pointed to countless stories of individuals who overcame difficult beginnings to lead meaningful lives, rejecting the notion that abortion “protects” by ending innocent existence.

In my work, I do a fair amount of counseling with individuals, couples and families dealing with some very troubling issues in their lives. I also do pre-marital counseling when I'm asked to perform a wedding ceremony. This type of work was never in my plan for ministry, but God had other ideas, and it seems He's called me to provide counsel more and more often lately. As people read our nationally-distributed Christian newspaper, hear my commentaries on the radio or watch our weekly TV program, many have sought me out with questions, to ask for prayer and to seek counsel.

In this message, I don't intend to betray any confidential information and certainly won't be mentioning any names. The issues I speak of may relate to you or someone you know, but understand that I'm talking about the most serious issues people contact me about in a general way, and not any specific person.

The troubles people are struggling with today are many, as they try to navigate through this sinful, fallen world the best they're able. Many people are living in unbearable circumstances, and have been for a very long time and things have not gotten any better for them. There are troubled marriages, people struggling with being unequally yoked with an unbelieving spouse, there are situations where children, raised in Christian homes, have fallen away from their faith and embraced all the sin and wickedness of worldly enticements. In many of these cases, the parents suffer terrible emotional turmoil, as they watch their children head full-speed down the highway to hell.

Worse yet, in many of these situations, the children want nothing to do with their parents anymore, and they've totally cut them out of their lives. The kids don't acknowledge their parents' birthdays, anniversaries or even Mothers' or Fathers' Day. Most rarely communicate with their parents, and some not at all.

Even more heartbreaking for these parents is when their children don't even allow them to see or have a relationship with their precious grandchildren. Perhaps you can't relate to this because it sounds so very dysfunctional. Make no mistake: it is very dysfunctional, and not at all healthy, yet it's becoming more and more common every day.

God's plan for marriage and family is one man united with one woman for a lifetime. This is the foundation of the natural family. Out of this union, should come many children. Through the trials and tribulations of life, no matter what may come, the husband and wife have vowed to remain together, "til death do we part." Interestingly, divorce rates have actually fallen in recent years, but I dare say there are more unhappy marriages being reported to me now than ever before. These couples may still be living together and married, but they are definitely not happily married.

God's plan also includes both the father and mother actively raising their children in an intact, Godly home, teaching the precepts of our Creator, our Heavenly Father to their little ones, from the youngest of ages. But you can't teach what you don't know, and sadly, we're now two, if not three generations beyond when most people had a genuine fear of the Lord and a real relationship with God the Father. The "seeker friendly" church movement began long before it became something that was recognized and labeled. Church teachings have been watered down so as to be non-offensive and therefore, ineffective in training up Godly disciples.

For decades, parents have been taught by the church to leave the spiritual training of their kids to the "professionals," and so, while most Christian couples may faithfully attend church, they turned the training up of their children over to Sunday School teachers and so-called "Childrens' Church" and the Youth Groups. In these

programs, if there's a curriculum at all, it's "church-lite, even lighter than the cotton candy they dish out to the adults — absolutely useless "teaching" as they tell the kids Bible "stories." The teachers, usually parents who volunteer for these jobs with no training whatsoever, are themselves unable to teach what they've never learned, and will simply tell a quick story, then hand out a snack and a page to color with crayons and just try to make it through until the end of the service when the parents come to pick the kids up.

What have these children learned? Fairy tales. Instead of teaching God's Word as HISTORY, they've been taught "stories," been given a snack and a time-wasting "craft" project to do. There is very little, if any, truth taught. And this — an hour of this once a week — has become the extent of the "spiritual training" that most churches provide today. Unfortunately, this model has been going on for decades. It's "Happy Fun Time" for the kids, but they're definitely not getting trained as young disciples of Christ. Nothing of relevance is taught; they know nothing about the spiritual warfare they'll face in the real world, and nothing of the power of God through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

Then they spend 40 hours a week in the public schools, where all the "fairy tale" stories they've heard in Childrens' Church are dispelled as nonsense and superstition and what little they heard about God is replaced with things like evolution, sex education, "social justice" and atheism. The parents, grossly inept at spiritual guidance themselves, then wonder what happened, when their ten-year-old son decides he wants to be a girl; or their 14-year-old daughter becomes pregnant; or their kids end up addicted to drugs, swearing like the devil with every sentence they speak, and seeking out foul-mouthed "rap stars" as their heroes and role models.

*"What in the world happened? After all, we took them to church every week!"* Yeah, there's your answer. You left the spiritual training to a system where there was never any spiritual "meat" fed to them, and biblical history was taught as fairy tales and then when they went home, they observed their parents living no differently from their worldly, unsaved neighbors. Yes, I know, SOME parents *are* true disciples and followers of Christ and their lives show it and their kids know it. But these cases are definitely rare.

It's a far cry from what Moses commanded the people in Deuteronomy 6: *"These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Bind them as a sign on your hand and let them be a symbol on your forehead. Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."* These words Moses spoke were the commands of God Almighty, and nothing was or is more important. But how seriously do we take this admonition today? In most homes — even most Christian homes — God is never even mentioned and His Word is never even opened, much less made a priority, studied and read as a family on a regular basis. And we wonder what in the world has happened to our families.

We all know the verse, *"Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old, he will not depart from it."* Today so many wonder why their child has become a heathen, an atheist, an anarchist and a God-hater. If you hear nothing else of what I'm telling you today, understand this: there is NO SUBSTITUTE for genuine Christianity. Calling yourself a Christian while living like the world and having no time for God but plenty of time for hobbies, parties, vacations, television, and Facebook is nothing short of taking the Lord's name in vain. Our kids watch everything we do. If the things of God are totally unimportant and irrelevant to us in our daily lives, never lived out in the home, and mocked and ridiculed in their public school, movies, music and everywhere else, what conclusion would you expect the kids to arrive at? *"Train up a child in the way he should go..."* YOU have to do that. You can't delegate that most vital responsibility to anyone else. It's up to you. So if you're wondering what has happened to your kids and grandkids, there — most likely — is your answer.

I'm also often called upon for prayer and counseling for troubled marriages. This is much more common than one might think, and once again, even in so-called "Christian" homes. I hear from people where the husband and wife have slept in separate beds, and even separate parts of the house, for years. I hear from wives whose husbands won't even sit at the same table with them for a meal — they just grab something from the fridge and eat on the couch while watching TV. There are many, both men and women, now addicted to pornography, since it's become so readily and easily available on the internet and smart phones. Rather than a loving, intimate bond with their

spouse, it's simply easier to view sex acts online and live a fantasy life while building emotional walls that separate them from their spouse.

What's happened to these couples? Obviously, there was a time when they were deeply in love, when the husband would do anything to court the girl, serve her, impress her, be a gentleman to her, and try his hardest to win her attention and eventually her hand in marriage. Obviously there was a time when they walked down the aisle together and made vows before God to love and serve one another's needs for life. In good times and in bad, in sickness and in health, for richer or poorer, as long as they both should live. It wasn't that long ago... but now, they're two separate people living under the same roof, and can't seem to say a pleasant word to one another, sometimes for weeks on end. In some cases, it's been years.

Once again, while they may have had a "Church Wedding," those who struggle with these matters often have no real relationship with the Lord. They don't pray together, study the Word together or minister to others together. Jesus stands at the door and knocks at these homes, but Facebook, TV, hobbies and games take priority.

Most times there's a great deal of selfishness going on in these homes. As the hurt gets worse and the hearts grow harder, it becomes more difficult for the husband and wife to genuinely care and serve one another. The importance of a heart of humility and service is repeatedly emphasized all throughout Scripture. Think of Jesus washing the feet of His disciples. He told them, *"whoever wishes to be the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven will be the servant of all."*

Some of you men may get angry with me for saying this, but I lay most of the responsibility for all these matters directly on your shoulders. Certainly it takes both spouses to make a Godly marriage and family. But God has called us men to be the spiritual leaders of our homes. Yet how many of us have grown up in homes where "Mom" was the one who tucked us in with bedtime prayers, who took us to church, who read us the Scriptures and modeled her faith in real life for us — while "Dad" pursued his work, his hobbies and recreation?

God also told us all, as Paul wrote to the Ephesians, *"Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her."* In my counseling, I often ask men who claim to love their wives if they would give themselves up for her. Would they lay down their lives for her? *"Absolutely,"* they respond, without a moment's hesitation. Then I ask, *"But are you willing to lay down the porn, the alcohol, the fishing, the TV remote, the Facebook... are you willing to lay those things down for her? Do you think you even can?"* I get a blank stare.

There are many troubled people, troubled marriages, dysfunctional families, broken homes, wayward children, grandparents in anguish because their grandchildren are growing up estranged from them and in Godless, secular homes. Friends, the only answer to all these things is humble repentance and turning once again — or for some, for the very first time — to God our Father and Creator, and Jesus His Son. The Christian life is not one of ease, but the alternative, as we see so often now from the seeds we've sown, is pure anguish. Invite the Holy Spirit to guide you. Pray without ceasing. Do what you know is right, and start making your professed faith a real, true priority in your lives today. There's no other way, no magic pill, no quick fix. Either you're serious, or you're not.

## The Fearful American — The Reason Charlie Kirk Is Today Dead

When you say, "No" to a face mask, it is so much more.

When you say, "No" to the death jab, it is so much more.

America has numerous founding documents, the most fundamental of those is the Bible. Appropriately, America's second president, John Adams, wrote in 1798 in a [letter to the Massachusetts Militia](#), "Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious People. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other."

Freedom and morality are partners, freedom cannot exist absent morality.

When you say, "Yes" to a child who needs to be told no, it is so much more.

When you say, "Yes" to a stranger misbehaving, it is so much more.

Your bold presence and your calm authority is needed everywhere you go.

There may be penalties for that. In fact, that is what most people say to me when I say that. They bring up the penalties that come with upright behavior.

Well, the fact that you bring up penalties in response to my insistence that you do the right thing, is simply proof that you are among the problem. You are among the fearful Americans — those who live in what is arguably the most free culture that has ever existed, arguably the most well-developed civilization on the planet, and you do not promote that, but you cower in fear. You fear what someone will say to you. You fear what someone will do to you. You shirk from responsibility, "[so you can live to fight another day.](#)" You shirk from responsibility so there "[can be peace in my day.](#)"

The coward is a moral cheapskate. He is unwilling to spend the capital. He is unwilling to spend the capital that it takes to build an upright society. He is very much willing to live in one, but when he is called on to build that society, he all of a sudden has nothing to offer.

And you see, the year is not 1953 anymore, nor is it 1973, nor 1993. Behaving yourself does not cut it. Back in the day when you were a mooch, living off the upright moral courage of others, maybe that did the job, but not today. An upright society is not formed by simply behaving. And we have a society that is today not upright, and that needs very much to return to being upright — and without a totalitarian to bring it to that place.

Because then, freedom is lost. Freedom is lost if we turn it all over to the strongman and ask us to build it for us. We will have neither freedom nor security from that cowardice.

When tasked with that work, you say it is just too expensive for you to stop and correct every misbehaving person in your life, it is too expensive for you to only stay silent around upright behavior. You profess freedom, but you show an unwillingness to do what it takes to return to freedom. If all you can do is to yourself behave upright and to be silent whenever anyone misbehaves around you, again, you are very much part of the problem of this era we live in.

You are the one who has always been a problem in a free society, because without your willingness to pay a price, there will be no freedom in your midst in your life. I am not saying there needs to be 51% of the population that behaves a certain way or 33% or 3% or any other number. That is a fatally flawed collectivist way of seeing the world. The world simply does not work that way. The way you behave impacts how the world around you treats you. That is how the world works — whether there be a so-called “critical mass” of people doing the same thing or not.

You, on your own, can be a leader walking through the world as a responsible man and consequently as a free man, or you can be an unfree man in the world. The rest of the world will tend to give you back what you give to it. The world may not like how you treat it. The world may wince or react loudly or violently at how you treat it. But you will generally be treated just as well as you treat the world around you. You will generally receive the standard back that you allow around you.

When you say nothing to a face mask, absolutely nothing, to a face mask worn in your presence, it is so much more.

When you say nothing to a child who needs to be told, “No,” it is so much more.

When you say nothing to a stranger misbehaving, it is so much more.

Those are the moments where society is formed. Those are the moments when an upright people are shaped. Those little areas of cultural pushback are times when you are able to grow the increasingly stronger spine that you need to live an upright life and to lead others.

This is not about a face mask.

This is about so much more.

“It is not my job!” you throw your hands up and say when a ghetto dweller acts ghetto in your presence, in a place that is not the ghetto. No, Sir, it is your job. It is your job to tell him to behave himself or to get out of there. Might you get shot

when you do that. Maybe. But probably not. The more practice you get, the less likely you getting hurt becomes.

Again, the fact that you bring up penalties in response to my insistence that you do the right thing, is simple proof that you are among the problem. You are among the fearful Americans.

"It is not my job!" you throw your hands up and say when a child misbehaves in your presence and a parent does nothing. No, Sir, it is your job. It is your job to tell him to behave himself or to get out of there. It is your job to scold the parent for what takes place too. Might you get shot when you do that. Maybe. But probably not.

Again, the fact that you bring up penalties in response to my insistence that you do the right thing, is simple proof that you are among the problem. You are among the fearful Americans. When you stand up in such moments, you become better at standing up in such moments. When you speak bravely in such moments, you become better at speaking bravely in such moments. When you insist on a certain standard around you, you become better at insisting on a certain standard around you.

We are in a point in time where there are no standards.

People have the spurious debate about whether one should back the blue and have stricter policing or whether cops need to be more strictly watched for misfeasance. Both are true. The police need to be watched carefully and kept decent in their behavior, and there needs to be strict policing of crime. However, the police are not the answer. The totalitarian approach of stricter policing solving the problem of a morally lax people is a cat-and-mouse game that never works and that leads society down a bad path.

A more moral people is the real answer, a more moral people is the real answer that is needed from that distracting and spurious debate. If you are caught in that debate, you are missing the real answer. It can hardly be a surprise that such a debate is so often thrust in front of the public — because it never leads to the right answer.

The right answer is to work on yourself, and to lead everywhere you go, by example, but with more, with a much more important step — by not allowing nonsense in your presence.

The stop-gap answer is more policing. It's not enough. It can help in an emergency. It's not enough.

Having an upright man in a community is needed — a man who understands freedom, who understands morality, and who demands a modicum of each from all of those who wish to be around him. I am talking all day long. All day long, if there is another human being around you, it is your job to have a modicum of freedom

and a modicum of decency from that person. And if there is not, it is your job to speak up.

The Karens are to be lauded, because they speak up.  
The BLM protestors and cancel culture mob are laudable because they speak up.  
The trannies who parade around the way they wish to are laudable because they speak up.

These people show the right behaviors required for shaping a society, only they tend to lack the moral underpinning in what they are doing.

That is where you come in.

"Live and let live," may be a great saying when it comes to government regulation, but that is not what I am talking about. I am talking about how to have a functioning society that does not need the government regulation. To have a day around other people that is "live and let live," is a day in which you abrogate responsibility.

When you know that something is right or wrong, you need to speak that openly when aberrant behavior presents itself.

The time for coasting on the foundations built a century or more ago has passed.

I do not need to know who shot Charlie Kirk.

I do not care what lie I may or may not be told when the news starts to tell a story about who killed Charlie Kirk.

I know I live in a fearful America, a place that fears consequences too greatly to say, "No" to evil.

I know how significant that is.

That daily behavior, that daily unwillingness of upright man to communicate to his environment what is right and what is wrong, daily, all day long, leads to a decay that leads to the Charlie Kirk assassination and worse.

America is in a dark, dark place.

You do not realize the role you play in it when you abrogate responsibility.

You do not realize how hard it is to get back to what we had.

My Muslim friends, my Jewish friends, my atheist friends might not like this, but that will not stop me from pointing out a further detail of this dissolution of values and courage in America.

America does not need Trump, nor does it need any other man to save it.

America needs Jesus.

And America needs men who will stand up and stop letting everything around them fall apart. You can lead those in your midst, or you can watch those around you be led by the worst of influences. That choice is yours.

That choice is entirely yours.

Charlie Kirk's lifeless body is in a casket because Americans lost the ability to identify evil and to denounce it in their midst.

What comes next in your life is up to you.

You can't change the whole world.

But you can shape the part of the world that you interact with.

That choice is entirely yours.

# The Courage To Stand Alone In An Age Of Cowards

The bravest souls are rarely the loudest in the room, but they are often the most misunderstood.

In an age when conformity is dressed up as virtue and applause is the currency of self-worth, those who refuse to play by the script become lightning rods. They provoke discomfort simply by existing in truth. They trigger the insecure, unsettle the complacent, and disturb the carefully curated illusions of the fake.

We like to imagine that the pressure to conform ends with adolescence, with the awkward teenage years when belonging matters more than authenticity. But [Solomon Asch's conformity experiments](#) in the 1950s proved otherwise. In a simple exercise—identifying which line matched another in length—he planted actors in the room to all give the same obviously wrong answer. Time and again, the lone real participant abandoned the truth they could plainly see with their own eyes and went along with the group. **Three out of four conformed at least once. Not because they were fooled, but because they did not want to stand out.** The fear of sticking out, of being “that person,” overpowered reality itself.

**And here is the sobering part: that experiment never ended.**

It repeats itself every day in classrooms, workplaces, media echo chambers, and politics.

**People choose the safety of the crowd over the solitude of truth.** They surrender what they know is real because they do not want the chill of unpopularity or the sting of rejection. The applause comes cheap, but the price of dissent feels unbearable.

Pair that with [Stanley Milgram's obedience studies](#) in the 1960s—where 65 percent of participants willingly administered what they thought were lethal shocks to another person simply because an authority told them to—and you see the bleak pattern. Obedience to authority and conformity to the crowd are the twin forces that crush truth. And yet, every turning point in history has been authored by those who resisted both—the prophets, the dissidents, the whistleblowers, and the reformers.

**To live this way is to accept loneliness as a companion.** It is to endure suspicion, ridicule, and rejection, not because one is wrong but because one refuses to settle for the comforting lie. Truth costs dearly, but its reward is integrity: an internal compass that does not lose its bearing when the crowd veers off course.

Applause fades. It always does.

**What endures is the quiet, steady force of those who never sold out, never bent, and never exchanged their essence for acceptance.** They may never be fully understood in their time, but they will always be remembered as the ones who saw clearly, stood firmly, and lived bravely.

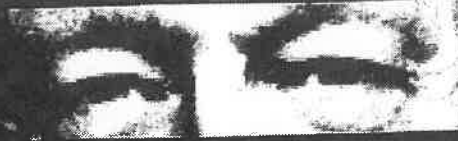
